

Study of Children with Autism

Your child may be eligible for a study at the National Institute of Mental Health (NIMH) if he/she:

- Is between 1 and 4 years of age (up to his/her 5th birthday)
- Has concerning signs of autism
- Is diagnosed with autism

Participation includes a comprehensive developmental evaluation, physical examination and follow-up assessments. Parents will receive a summary of findings from testing. There is no charge for study-related evaluations. Travel assistance is provided.

Children must:

- be available to come to the NIH Clinical Center in Bethesda, Maryland for:
 - an initial evaluation
 - 2 to 6 follow-up visits, to be determined by age of entry
